

The Paper has focused on analysis and interpretation of profitability of the fertilizer units in Solapur District. For that purpose, this paper is divided into two parts, first on Gross Profit and second part on Gross profit ratio is profitability ratio and it also known as gross margin ratio. The net profit is that portion of net revenue which is available to the proprietors Profitability indicates and measures the performances in form of overall efficiency of the Fertilizer Units.

Introduction

In this research paper has used the profitability concept for analysis and interpretation of data for selected fertilizer units in study area that is Solapur District. Profitability is the main tool generally used by the researcher for evaluating an organisation. Profitability indicates and measures the performances in form of overall efficiency of the business. The profits is known as excess of incomes over its expenses for a given period. The following are important profitability ratio:

- A) On the basis of sales profitability ratio are1. Gross Profit Ratio, 2. Net Profit Ratio, 3. Operating Profit Ratio, 4. Operating Ratio and 5. Various Expenses Ratio.
- B) On the basis of return on investments, profitability ratio are1. Return on Total Assets, 2. Return on Capital Employed, 3. Return on Equity, Earnings PerShare and5. Earnings Per Dividend.

For analysis and interpretation of profitability of the selected fertilizer units in the study area, researcher has used two ratios based on sales which are 1. Gross Profit Ratio (GPR) and 2. Net Profit Ratio (NPR)

Analysis & Interpretations of Gross Profit Ratio (GPR)

Gross profit ratio is profitability ratio and it also known as 'gross margin ratio' or 'gross profit rate'. Gross profit ratio is calculated as gross profit divided by net sales into hundred and it is expressed in percentage. As for as gross profit ratio is concern, there are three important elements that is net sales, cost of goods sold and gross profit. Gross margin is the profit calculated on sales or turnover. It can be defined as the excess of sales volume over cost of goods sold. Cost of goods sold is the total cost of materials, labour and various

werheads. The net sales means that gross sales minus sales return. In short, gross profit ratio shows a relationship between gross margin and net sales volume.



The above numerical table no. 1 and graph no. 2 has shown Gross Profit Ratio (GPR) of Vardhman Fertilizer & Seeds Private Limited, District Solapur. The GPR in financial year 2012-2013 was 9.07%, in 2013-2014 was 22.03%, in 2014-2015 was 20.10%, in 2015-2016 was 19.41% and in 2016-2017 it was 12.55%. Total of GPR in five years was in 83.17%, arithmetic mean was 16.63%, standard derivation was 4.96% and coefficient variance it was 29%. In financial year 2013-2014 the GPR was highest and in 2012-2013 it was lower as compare to other years. The chart show that the green curve line of GPR went up in second year and there after it has decreases in all selecting financial years.

The average GPR of five years was 16.63% which is unsatisfactory. It means this fertilizer units was having ineffective sales management, cost of control, management strategy and policy and over valuation of stock.






